## PER CURIAM:

Jonathan T. Alston appeals the district court's orders dismissing his Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, Maryland Consumer Debt Collection Act, and state law defamation claims, granting summary judgment for Defendant on his Fair Credit Reporting Act claim, denying his various motions, and denying reconsideration.
