PER CURIAM:

Willie Brian Williams appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2012). We have reviewed the record and find that this appeal is frivolous. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for the reasons stated by the district court. Williams v. Ahmed, No. 1:14-cv-00880-TSE-JFA (E.D.
