PER CURIAM:

Kevin Lou English appeals the district court's order denying relief on his complaint filed pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. English v. Johns, No. 5:11-ct-03206-D (E.D.N.C. Feb. 11, 2014).
