PER CURIAM:

Oscar Robles appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1) (2012). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Robles's motions for preparation of transcript at government expense and for appointment of counsel and affirm the district court's judgment. Robles v.
