PER CURIAM:

Kareem Milhouse appeals the district court's order adopting the recommendation of the magistrate judge in part and dismissing his complaint filed pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). We have reviewed the record and conclude that Milhouse fails to establish reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Milhouse v. O'Brien, No. 1:14-cv-00016-IMK-JES (N.D.W. Va. May 9, 2014).
