PER CURIAM:

Randle Cooke appeals the district court's order dismissing his complaint filed pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), for failure to state a claim under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) (2012). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Cooke v. Holder, No. 5:13-ct-03268-FL (E.D.N.C. June 6, 2014).
