PER CURIAM:

Sherman B. Jenkins seeks to appeal the district court's order dismissing as untimely his 28 U.S.C. § 2254 (2012) petition. The district court referred this case to a magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) (2012). The magistrate judge recommended that the petition be dismissed and advised Jenkins that failure to file timely objections to this recommendation could waive appellate review of a district court order based upon the recommendation.

The timely filing of specific objections to а magistrate judge's recommendation is necessary to preserve appellate review of the substance of that recommendation when parties have been warned the of the consequences of Wright v. Collins, 766 F.2d 841, 845-46 (4th noncompliance. Cir. 1985); see also Thomas v. Arn, 474 U.S. 140 (1985). failing to waived appellate review by Jenkins has file objections. Accordingly, deny certificate of а we appealability, deny leave to proceed in forma pauperis, and dismiss the appeal.
