PER CURIAM:

James Lester Roudabush, Jr., seeks to appeal the district court's September 22, 2014 order granting his motion for voluntary dismissal of one defendant, denying his motions to and expedite, denying his motion relating to withdrawal of funds from his inmate account, dismissing another defendant, and requesting that the remaining defendants return waivers of service. This court may exercise jurisdiction only over final orders, 28 U.S.C. § 1291 (2012), and interlocutory and collateral orders, 28 U.S.C. § 1292 (2012); Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(b); Cohen v. Beneficial Indus. Loan Corp., 337 U.S. 541, 545-47 (1949). The order Roudabush seeks to appeal is neither a final order nor an appealable interlocutory or collateral order. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
