PER CURIAM:

Charles A. Williams appeals the district court's order dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the Appellant's brief. See 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because Williams does not challenge in his informal brief the basis for the district court's disposition, he has forfeited appellate review of the court's order.
