PER CURIAM:

Willie Joe Sturkey appeals the district court's order accepting in part the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny his motions to appoint counsel and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See Sturkey v.
