PER CURIAM:

Iftikhar H. Saiyed appeals the district court's order dismissing, without prejudice to any state law claims Saiyed may have against Defendant 3-S Network Inc. ("3-S"), his civil action alleging 3-S wrongfully terminated his employment. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
