PER CURIAM:

Samuel Irvin White petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (2012) motion. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court entered an order and judgment on November 16, 2015, denying relief on White's § 2255 motion. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided White's case, we deny the mandamus petition as moot. We grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
