PER CURIAM:

Piper A. Rountree appeals the district court's orders denying relief on her 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint and her Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Rountree v. Brown, No. 7:11-cv-00572-GEC-RSB (W.D. Va.
