PER CURIAM:

Jeff Farmer appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Farmer's motions to reexamine filing in forma pauperis, for appointment of counsel, for injunctive relief, and to amend the complaint, and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court.
