PER CURIAM:

Robert Lee Saunders appeals the district court's order denying his motion to reduce his sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c) (2012) and Amendment 782 to the Sentencing Guidelines. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Saunders, No. 5:10-cr-00018-FPS-JSK-1 (N.D.W. Va.
