PER CURIAM:

Roderick Arnez Whitaker appeals the district court's order granting his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for sentence reduction based on Amendment 782 to the Sentencing Guidelines. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Whitaker's motion for appointment of counsel and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See United States v. Whitaker, No. 5:09-cr-00125-BR-1 (E.D.N.C. Sept. 11, 2015).
