PER CURIAM:

Larry Felentise Rambert petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging that the district court has unduly delayed in ruling on various pending cases. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court and state court to act. We find the present record does not reveal undue delay in the district court. In addition, we do not have jurisdiction to grant mandamus relief against state officials. Accordingly, we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis and deny the mandamus petition.
