Howard Antonia Gosnell, Glenda Grantham Gosnell, and Robin Gosnell Logan appeal the district court's order granting judgment on the pleadings for the Appellee on its complaint for a declaratory judgment regarding coverage for an accident caused by an underinsured motorist. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Nationwide Prop. & Cas. Ins. Co. v.
