PER CURIAM:

Ajamu Sawandi Osborne petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging that the district court has unduly delayed in ruling on his "application for out of time reconsideration and review of a sentence imposed in violation of records accuracy laws and constitution," which Osborne filed while his direct appeal was pending.
