PER CURIAM:

Mostafa Ahmed Awwad petitions for a writ of mandamus seeking an order from this court directing the district court to unseal certain documents and filings in his underlying criminal case. But our review of the district court's docket reveals that Awwad is incorrect in his view that the district court has sealed any of the identified documents.
