PER CURIAM:

Nigel Nicholas Douglas appeals the district court's order granting his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for sentence reduction based on Amendment 782 to the Sentencing Guidelines, as well as its order denying his motion to alter or amend judgment. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's orders. See United States v. Douglas, No. 2:93-cr-00131-HCM-7 (E.D. Va.
