PER CURIAM:

Derek Hendricks appeals the district court's orders granting Defendants summary judgment on Hendricks' 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint, in which Hendricks alleged an Eighth Amendment claim of deliberate indifference to his serious medical condition, and denying Hendricks' postjudgment motion for reconsideration.
