PER CURIAM:

Billy R. McCullers, Jr., appeals from the district court's margin order denying his motion filed in his criminal case under Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(c)(2) to relate back a new claim to his previously adjudicated and denied 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (2012) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
