PER CURIAM:

Ras. Stefen E. Harris appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge, granting defendants' motion for summary judgment, and denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Harris v. Warden*, No. 0:15-cv-04173-HMH (D.S.C. Aug. 12, 2016).
