PER CURIAM:

Gene Everette Washington appeals the district court's orders dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint for failure to state a claim and denying his subsequent motions to reopen and to continue. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Washington v. Mooney*, No. 7:15-cv-00514-JLK-RSB (W.D. Va. Sept. 13, 2016; Oct. 20, 2016). We further deny Washington's motion to suppress seized evidence.
