Please file your corrected amicus brief within the time frame established by the court's March 23, 2017, order- amicus briefs on behalf of plaintiffs supporting affirmance must be filed by April 19, 2017. The corrected brief may address both the motion for stay and the merits but may not exceed 6,500 words and must comply with Fed. R. App. P. (a)(1)-(4).
