PER CURIAM:

Ronald Satish Emrit appeals the district court's order dismissing his civil complaint for improper venue. On appeal, we limit our review to the issues raised in Emrit's informal brief. *Jackson v. Lightsey*, 775 F.3d 170, 177 (4th Cir. 2014). We have reviewed the record in light of these arguments and find no reversible error.
