PER CURIAM:

Hamid Mahjor appeals the district court's order dismissing his civil action asserting numerous claims arising out of a foreclosure sale of his home. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Mahjor v.
