PER CURIAM:

Karl Heinz Krey appeals the district court's order dismissing his case for lack of subject matter jurisdiction based on the discretionary function exception to the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1346(b)(1), 2680(a) (2012). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Krey v. United States*, No. 8:15-cv-03800-DKC (D. Md. June 28, 2017).
