PER CURIAM:

Dr. Ning Shen appeals the district court's order dismissing her action against the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Martinsburg, West Virginia. We have reviewed the record, as well as the parties' briefing in this matter, and find no reversible error. *See Hux v. City of Newport News*, 451 F.3d 311, 315 (4th Cir. 2006) (a plaintiff's failure to demonstrate a genuine issue of material fact regarding pretext warrants summary judgment).
