PER CURIAM:

Joseph J. Bellinger, the trustee in Joyce Buckley's Chapter 7 bankruptcy proceeding, appeals from the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order overruling Bellinger's objection to Buckley's claimed exemption in certain real property. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Bellinger v. Buckley*, No. 1:17-cv-00068-JKB (D. Md. Aug. 29, 2017).
