PER CURIAM:

Syed Askri appeals the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order dismissing his Chapter 13 proceeding and dismissing as moot his appeal from the bankruptcy court's order granting First Horizon Bank's motion for relief from the automatic stay.
