PER CURIAM:

Jay Bonanza Briley appeals the district court's order denying his motions for a reduction in sentence, for summary judgment, and for production of sealed records for use in his civil case, and granting the Government's motion to seal an exhibit Briley filed. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Briley*, No. 1:12-cr-00482-LO-1 (E.D. Va. filed May 16, 2017; entered May 17, 2017).
