## PER CURIAM:

Marcus Terrell Burney appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for reduction of sentence. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. *See United States v. Mann*, 709 F.3d 301, 304 (4th Cir. 2013) (reviewing district court's decision under § 3582(c)(2) for abuse of discretion). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Burney*, No. 7:12-cr-00068-D-1 (E.D.N.C. July 5, 2017).
