PER CURIAM:

Kunta Kenta Redd appeals the district court's order denying his post-judgment motion seeking appointment of counsel. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the Appellant's brief. *See* 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because Redd's informal brief does not challenge the bases for the district court's disposition, Redd has forfeited appellate review of the court's order. *See Williams v. Giant Food Inc.*, 370 F.3d 423, 430 n.4 (4th Cir. 2004). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment. We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
