PER CURIAM:

Kristian Taguinod appeals the district court's orders dismissing his complaint, filed under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2017), as time-barred, and denying reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Taguinod v. Amazon.com, Inc.*, No. 3:17-cv-00276-HEH (E.D. Va.
