PER CURIAM:

Victor Motley, Sr., appeals from the district court's order dismissing Motley's complaint raising claims under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2016); the Age Discrimination in Employment Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 621-634 (2012); and 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Motley v. Virginia*, No. 3:16-cv-00595-MHL (E.D. Va. March 26, 2018).
