PER CURIAM:

Nicholas Omar Midgette petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging the district court has unduly delayed acting on his petition for a writ of error coram nobis or audita querela. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court denied the petition on June 29, 2018. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided Midgette's case, we deny the mandamus petition as moot. We grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis.
