PER CURIAM:

Andrew Chien appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his complaint filed pursuant to *Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics*, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), and denying reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
