PER CURIAM:

Travis Williams, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order adopting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2012) petition and the district court's order denying his motion for reconsideration under Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, although we grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Williams v. Warden, FCI Edgefield*, No. 1:17-cv-00946-JMC (D.S.C. Feb. 6 & July 27, 2018). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
