PER CURIAM:

Terrence Lovell Dickens appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 18 U.S.C § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for a sentence reduction based on Amendment 782 to the United States Sentencing Guidelines. "We review a district court's decision to grant or deny a sentence-reduction motion under § 3582(c)(2) for abuse of discretion." *United States v. Peters*, 843 F.3d 572, 577 (4th Cir. 2016).
