PER CURIAM:

Stephen D. Chamberlain appeals the district court's orders dismissing his amended complaint and denying reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error in the district court's rejection of Chamberlain's abuse of process claims, the only claims he raised on appeal.
