PER CURIAM:

Dennis Finbarr Murphy appeals the district court's order granting Defendants summary judgment on his employment-related claims, including his religion and national origin discrimination claims brought pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2019).
