PER CURIAM:

Loretta K. Bethea appeals the district court's orders granting Defendant's motion to dismiss and dismissing with prejudice Bethea's complaint alleging employment discrimination and retaliation after Bethea failed to file an amended complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Bethea v. Pollard*, No. 8:18-cv-02768-PX (D. Md.
