Monica Jeffries appeals the district court's order granting Defendant's motion to dismiss her complaint alleging disability discrimination and retaliation claims under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 12101 to 12213 (West 2013 & Supp. 2019).
