PER CURIAM:

William O. Cornick, Jr., appeals the district court's orders dismissing his complaint filed under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 12101-12213 (West 2013 & Supp. 2019), and denying his motions to alter or amend and file a second amended complaint.
