PER CURIAM:

William Carawan, Jr., appeals the district court's order denying his motion for contempt. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Carawan v. Solomon*, No. 5:16-ct-03269-FL (E.D.N.C. Dec. 10, 2018).
