PER CURIAM:

Anthony Newman appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment to the defendants in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) action alleging deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Newman v. Moultrie*, No. 8:18-cv-00457-TDC (D. Md. Dec. 18, 2018).
