## PER CURIAM:

Justin Paul Woodington appeals the district court's dismissal without prejudice of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint for failure to pay the initial filing fee or to apply to proceed in forma pauperis.\* We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
