PER CURIAM:

Kenneth Orlando Legrand appeals the district court's order granting his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for a sentence reduction based on Amendment 782 to the Sentencing Guidelines. On appeal, Legrand disputes the court's decision not to grant an even greater reduction. However, we have reviewed the record and discern no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Legrand*, No. 2:90-cr-00302-NCT-1 (M.D.N.C. Jan. 14, 2019). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
